Paying heed to the challenging times in the post Covid – times, the school organized a workshop headed by Mrs Era Sehgal, a freelancer. At the very forefront, Mrs Era was formally welcomed with a bouquet along with Sister Renuka who joined as the Vice - Principal. The workshop focused on teaching aids viz., supplementary videos, audios, e-books, and spectrum – books to hone end-to-end solutions in the academic pedagogy at the new Education Policy i.e. 5+3+3+4. She drew the attention of all to the sixty-four-thousand-dollar question as to what to teach & how to teach. She also extensively touched three – on

language formulas, core concepts, worksheets, even colored worksheets, and changes in school learning with the 7 c's of learning skills namely critical thinking, creativity & innovation, collaboration, cross – cultured understanding, communication, career learning ...etc. to be coupled with interactions, interpretations & internalizing essentials. She emphatically explained the core of learning as speaking results in 10% of learning while learning & doing up to 20% & 90% respectively. In the last part of the workshop, the staff was divided subject–wise to exhibit the storehouse of possibilities while teaching in the class.

Subsequently, all the groups came one by one to present their views. The workshop culminated in the inspired minds of the Theresian Staff and their warm smiles of infused confidence, optimism, and strength. The noted Psychologist of Fortis, (Noida) New Delhi, **Anusha Tyagi** conducted workshops at the campus of St Theresa's Convent Senior Sec. School, Karnal under the aegis of Sr Priya Therese the Principal on 9 August 2022. She dealt with the different age groups in three shifts focusing the talk on 'growing children'. In the first talk for Senior Secondary Classes, she spoke explicitly on mental health and well-being during the adolescent years. As it

was the burning need of the students as well as their parents owing to post – Covid times' lethargy, easy-go-lucky attitude, and lackadaisical approach towards studies. It was a counselling cum talk show to bring awareness among students as to how they should cope with the academic and non-academic areas, detoxing of cyber, and on-screen time.

She concentrated pragmatically on cyber bullying for classes VI to X. How it hurts the students who are victimized and how overindulgence makes them a complete fountainhead of pessimism which results in the gloom, pain, mental trauma, depression and even developing suicidal tendencies as the ugliest result of it. She candidly guided children with practical suggestions which can change pessimism into optimism, making them grow in holistic development and self-monitoring plans.

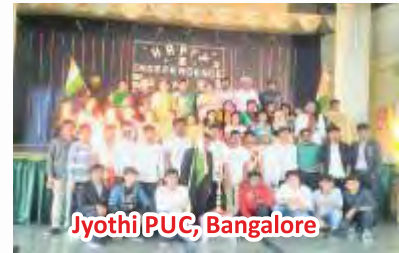

2. Student Development Activities

2.1 Innovations

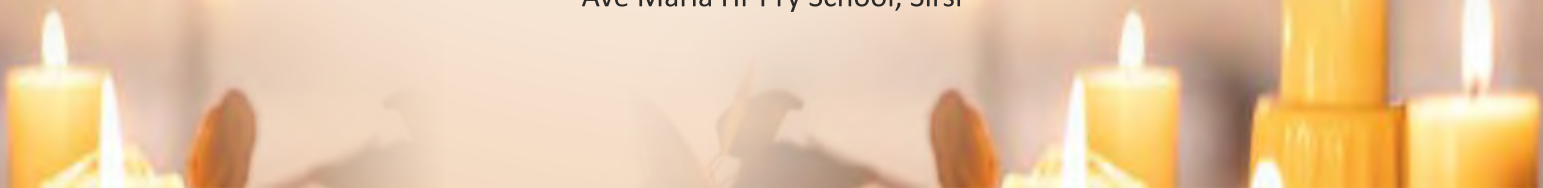

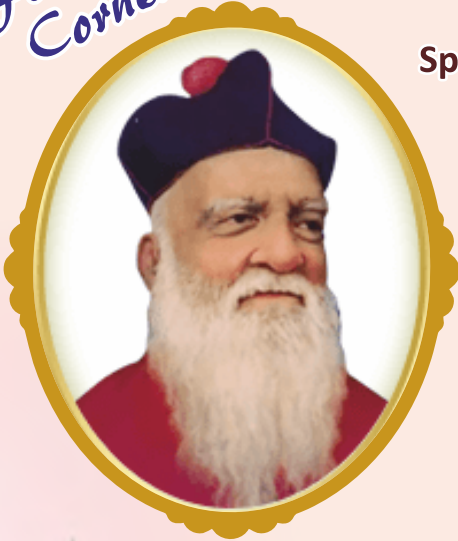
