It was the dream of Northern Province before the Eastern Province was carved out to have an English Medium School for the welfare of the Tribal Children in and around Ranchi. A village named Ushamatu 25 km away from the capital city of Ranchi had remained untouched by the missionaries was spotted out when his Eminence Cardinal Telesphore P Toppo invited the Bethany Sisters to acquire land at Ushamatu, Ratu Block, Ranchi District in Jharkhand from Mr Anthony Joseph, the proprietor of St Jude's International School. He was running a school and was compelled to close down due to the dispute between him and the villagers. A piece of property was purchased with an old school building which was used as school and residence for the sisters.

The convent and school was blessed and inaugurated on 19 March 2010 on the feast of St Joseph the Father and Protector of Bethany. The words of encouragement, advice and appreciation of his Eminence Cardinal Tolesphore P Toppo

boosted the morale of the sisters to begin their mission with much courage and enthusiasm. Sr Maria Nancy the Superior and Principal, Sr Alka Bindu and Sr Monthie Anita were the pioneers. They did the spade work by visiting the villagers, meeting people and motivating them to educate their children. Initially by visiting families the people were befriended by the sisters. Seeing the sisters running a school in their vicinity, many parents came forward to admit their children at Bethany Convent School, Ushamatu.

People of Ushamatu and surrounding villages were happy and grateful for the opportunity they






had to educate their children in English Medium School run by the sisters. Here we remember the tireless work of Sr Nora BS who took great trouble to negotiate and purchase the land.

On 7 December 2013 the new school building was inaugurated by Sr Wilberta, the then Superior General and was blessed by His Eminence Cardinal Telephore P Toppo.

Since then the school is making steady progress in number and in academic excellence. At present there are 618 students up to Std IX out of which 338 are boys and 280 are girls. They come from 27 villages belonging either to middle class or still poorer. Bus facilities are provided for those students who come from distant places. All possible efforts are made by the Management to maintain the standard of the school by appointing trained and qualified teachers and by providing remedial classes to the slow learners. At present the school has 20 qualified teaching staff and 5 nonteaching staff.



efforts of Sr Savina Nanda BS, the Principal. It is in the process of getting affiliated to the ICSE Board, New Delhi. Though in the village set-up, the school offers all facilities to achieve high academic standard through curricular and extracurricular activities and sports. Various competitions are also conducted to bring out the talents of students.

The school thrived under the leadership of Sr Maria Nancy BS from 2010-2016 and Sr Savina Nanda BS from 2016 onwards. Though many hurdles were on the way, by the grace of God the mission is being carried out with faith and trust in the Lord.

Hostel Ministry: In keeping with the charism of our founder, Bethany Tribal Home was opened in the year 2012 with four girls. The hostel is in view to offer educational facilities to the economically poor girls from far off villages. At present there are 29 girls in the hostel. A proper hostel building with required facilities is yet to be constructed. Some of them are sponsored and others are subsidized. Their physical, spiritual, material and psychological needs are taken care of by Sr Beena John, the Warden assisted by Sr Seema. They are committed to the care of children.



Bethany Convent, Ushamathu: There are 5 sisters namely Sr Madhu Kerketta, the Superior, Sr Savina Nanda, Sr Beena John, Sr Seema and Sr Sylvi. All of them are involved in the educational apostolate. They are always ready to render assistance to students and parents, giving a human touch to everyone who enters the campus. God is their strength in times of difficulties, especially in carrying forward the vision of the servant of God RFC Mascarenhas.



Labourer's Day


