

the global stage. His emphasis on uplifting the poor, especially girls through education, avoidance of corporal punishment and dignity of work as early as 1920's is indeed revolutionary.





Msgr Raymond Francis Camillus Mascarenhas, the founder of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Little Flower of Bethany, was a devout priest. He was born on 23 January 1875 to Lazarus Mascarenhas and Joanna Castelino. Msgr Raymond is a great model to the youth. His struggles from childhood to death are a great inspiration to us.

Msgr Raymond was a man of sharp memory and eloquence of speech. He was a dynamic preacher both in English and in Konkani. He lived a good priestly life and advised young men and women to do what was right.

Msgr Raymond had great compassion for the poor and the marginalized. He was ready to spend his life for the poor and the neglected. Today, do we ever find young men who will sacrifice their lives for the service of the poor?

Msgr Raymond was a dedicated educationist who imparted Christian principles in schools and He preached retreats to priests, parishes. religious and lay people. He made a great impact on the listeners by of his homilies.

Msgr Raymond laid great emphasis on education of poor girls. He believed in the saying "If a girl is educated, then the whole family is educated." We read in newspapers of today the fate of the girl child. The way she is ridiculed and harassed in the society! Mgr Raymond always respected women. That is why he started the Congregation of the Sisters of the Little Flower of Bethany in order to educate the girls and help them gain respect in the society.

His hard work brought forth schools such as St Sebastian School and St Margaret Mary School at Bendur, and St Joseph School at Kankanady, Mangalore. With hardly any money in his hand he was able to erect the parish church of St Sebastian, Bendur. If we work hard the way Msgr Raymond worked, we too can enjoy the fruit of our hard labour.

Msgr Raymond is considered a man of great courage. Although he had a lot of sufferings, trials and misunderstandings from various quarters, he did not lose hope. He had great faith in Jesus and Mother Mary and faced his trials courageously.

Msgr Raymond left for his eternal home peacefully on 23 December 1960, leaving behind footprints of hard work, dedication, sacrifice, courage, determination and encouragement. great inspiration to all of us. We, the youth should follow the path Msgr Raymond taught us through his life.

May the Lord grant to his servant, the honours of the altar, for the greater glory of God.
