I wish you dear staff and students a Blessed Christmas and a Happy New Year 2020 filled with Blessings!



Lives of great people are always a source of inspiration to others. It is amazing to see how a single person can change the course of history. There are people who have done it. In India we have many great political and religious leaders whose vision and life has influenced others. Msgr Raymond FC Mascarenhas is one of them.

The active and gifted Raymond grew up in faith, grounded in piety and good habits under firm parental discipline. His teachers loved him for his lofty ideas, broadmindedness, sincerity and openness. During his declining years one would see him surrounded by paper, pens, dictionaries, the Bible and popular hymns translated from Latin or English into vernacular. Indeed Father Founder grew up to be a great scholar.

He was always considerate of others even in little matters. When he stayed up late at night to read his lessons, he would sit with a candle under a table screening himself with bedspreads all around. He would say, "My studies should not disturb another's sleep." This same unselfishness characterized his later career as a seminarian, a priest and as the Founder of a Religious Congregation. The way he served people has taught us and encouraged us to do selfless service for others.

In spite of pressures from parents and relatives to pursue higher education for a different and esteemed profession, Raymond decided to take the road less travelled, which was the road to priesthood.

As a priest Fr Mascarenhas encouraged young boys and girls to dedicate their lives to God. The good example given by him was an inspiration to young men and women.

Raymond never frittered away his time even during holidays. He spent his vacations with his family and was an active helper at the parish. He would collect the little children in the neighbourhood and teach them good manners and prayers.

A life of reflection, silence, simplicity and great zeal to bring people closer to God were the special traits of his personality. Prayer was the breath of his life and he spent long hours in prayer.

Self-discipline, self-control, self-denial, self-determination and firmness are the qualities that made him a most extraordinary man. Education he believed is the only path towards development of the poor and transformation of the society. He founded the Bethany Educational Society in the year 1948 for this purpose.

Unless a seed dies, it cannot germinate, bloom and produce more seeds. The Servant of God RFC Mascarenhas who was born at Shimoga in Karnataka on 23 January 1875, surrendered himself into the loving arms of God on 23 December 1960. Raymond died but Bethany continues to live and grow.

Fr Raymond was a champion of the cause of education. He was a great luminary. His involvement with the youth made him an icon of youth. His beautiful words give us an encouraging message: "Why should I be an instrument of evil? I would rather go about doing good."
